Santa Clara County Parks and Recreation Department (SCCPR) is dedicated to preventing an infestation of invasive aquatic species in any of the reservoirs and/or waterways under its responsibility. After completing an evaluation of your vessel survey information and/or an inspection of your vessel, it has been determined that you may not launch your vessel at this reservoir or any other SCCPR reservoir. The reason for this restriction is because of one or more of the following:

_____ Upon inspection, this vessel was determined to have standing water in the live wells, bait wells, bilge area, or _____ (circle all that apply). You must drain, dry, and let stand dry for five (5) days any of the identified areas. Permission to launch in any SCCPR reservoir/waterway has been revoked for a period of five (5) days from the inspection date indicated on this form. You may return to launch on _____ provided that you meet all inspection criteria.

_____ Upon inspection, it was determined that this vessel *has been used in a high risk area*. These areas identified as high risk include San Justo Reservoir, any area south of the Tehachapi Mountains, or outside the State of California. Permission to launch in any SCCPR reservoir has been revoked for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of your last visit to any high risk waterway. You may return to launch on _____ provided that you meet all inspection criteria.

_____ Upon inspection, it was determined that your vessel is *from a high risk area*. These areas identified as high risk include any area south of the Tehachapi Mountains, or outside the State of California. Permission to launch this vessel at any SCCPR reservoir has been revoked indefinitely.

_____ Upon inspection, this vessel was suspected to have Quagga Mussels, Zebra Mussels, or other aquatic nuisance species. Permission to launch in any SCCPR reservoir has been revoked indefinitely. SCCPR will report the result of this inspection to California State Department of Fish & Game (CDFG) and you are requested to contact CDFG at 1-866-440-9530 to report this infestation as well. CDFG will have information regarding steps you must take to decontaminate your vessel and prevent the spread to other waterways. California Fish and Game Code Section 2301 makes it a crime to transport dreissenid mussels.

I _____ have read and understand the following reason(s) for the revocation or denial of my launching privileges. I agree not to attempt to launch this vessel in any SCCPR waterway for the time period specified. I understand that failure to comply by these instructions will lead to eviction, citation and/or extension of the period during which launching privileges may be denied.
